One of them was a student of mine from some time ago who came with her friend on Sunday morning. Others included a nurse that works with Hannah, along with her grown daughter, as well as a young Hindu student who is soon graduating from the medical school in San Antonio. So we were able to plant the seed and we hope and pray it germinates with these souls. Thanks God for these opportunities.

Our in-depth Sunday afternoon studies continue in Genesis with unit testing this coming Sunday. We are approaching this as one would when taking a course at any college or school of preaching so it is demanding.
